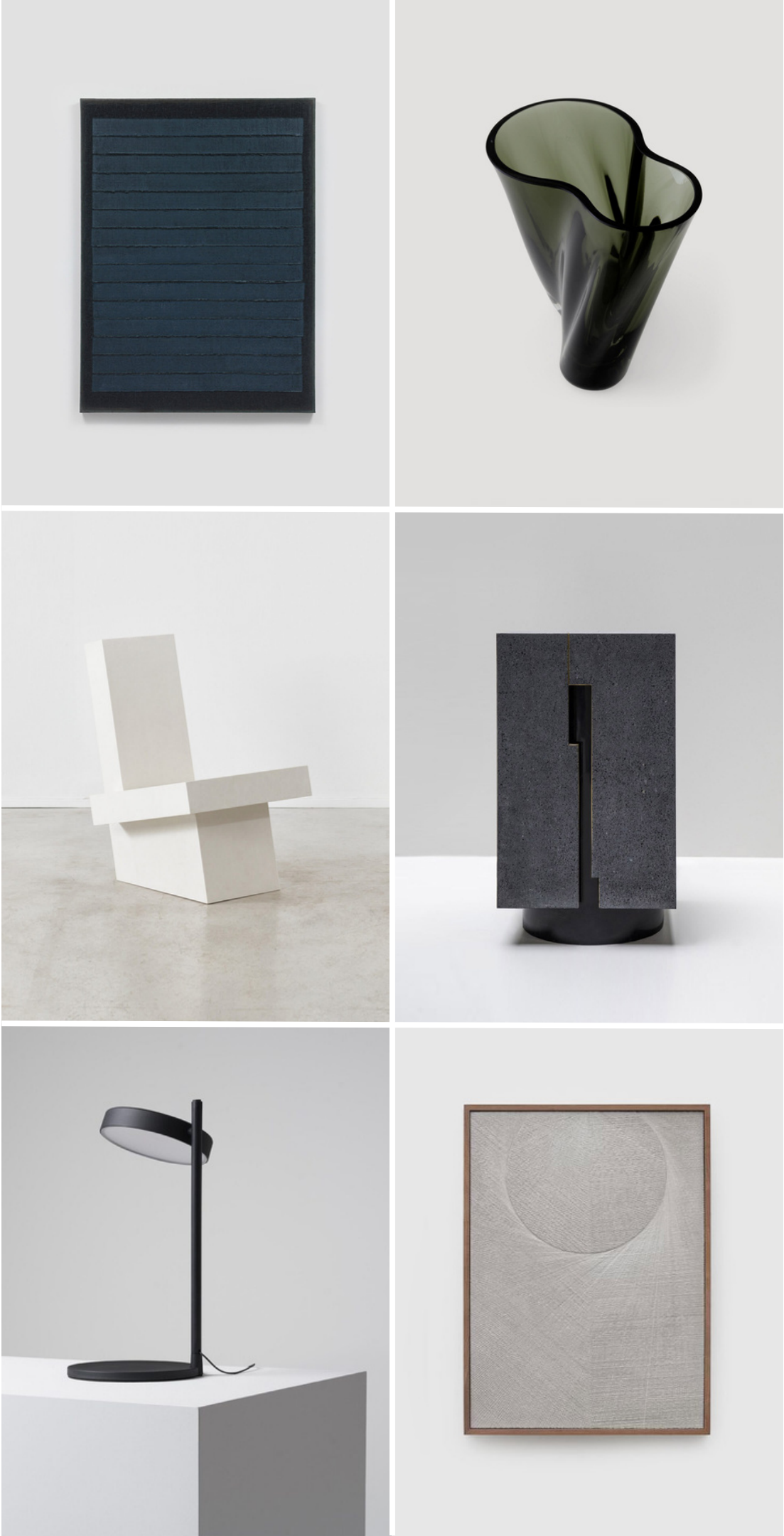

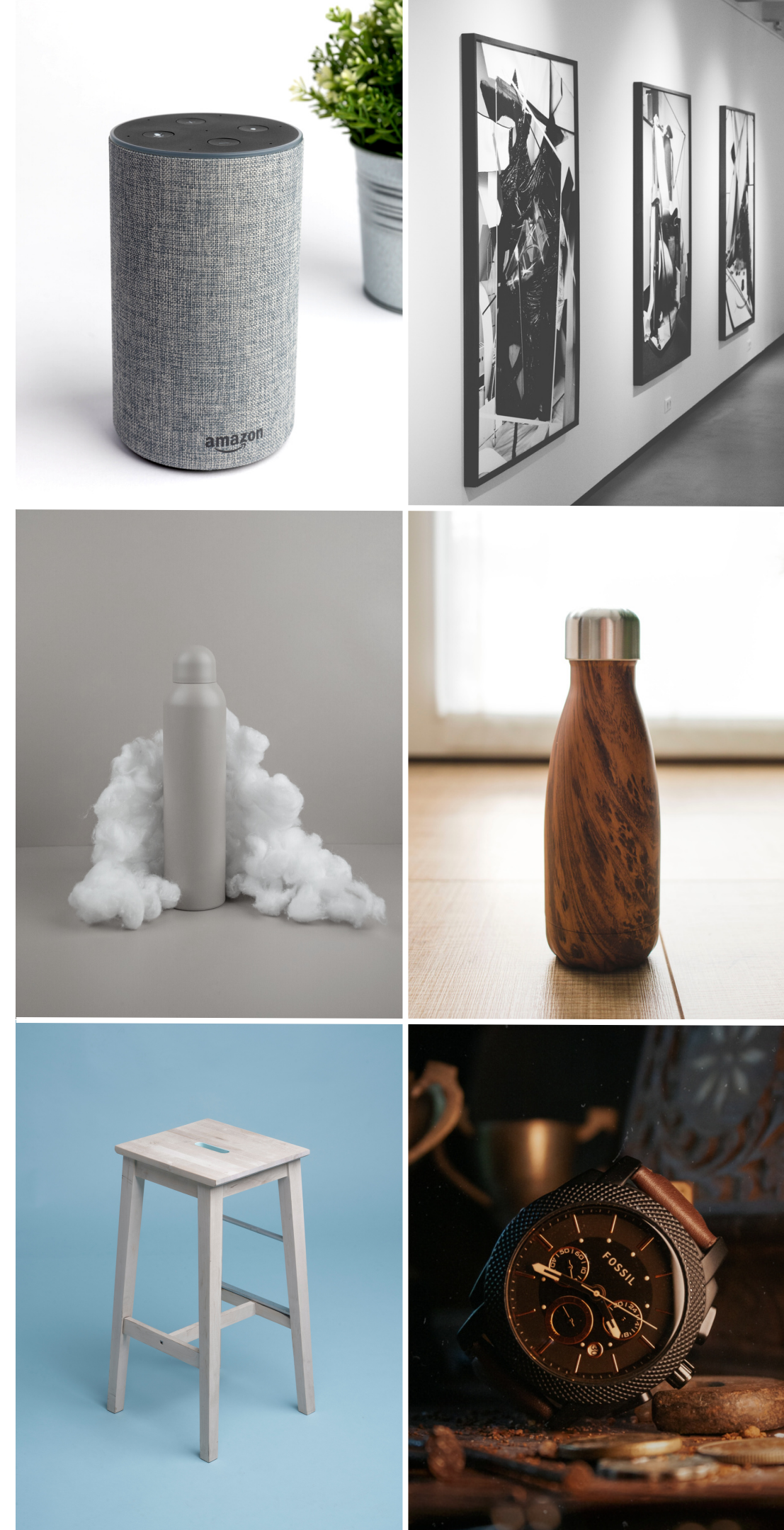
Examples of unaccepted photography

Due to their aesthetics, the photos on the right do not match to Aesence for the following reasons:

- Black and white images or almost completely desaturated photos
- Poorly lit or badly aligned lines
- Too many other objects/shadows/etc. in the background that distract from the actual product/art object
- The use of colors that are too bright and do not fit into the overall concept of the website
- Too much contrast
